A.L.I.C.E.

- Discuss possible alerts that might be heard that tells us that there is an intruder in our school.
- Discuss how to barricade this classroom or other classrooms in the building.
- Discuss the closest outside exit.
- Discuss locations for evacuation.

- What if I am in the hallway or bathroom? You should find the closest exit and evacuate the building. If you cannot run out of the building, find a safe place to lockdown or barricade.
- Will I get in trouble for leaving the building? You will <u>absolutely not</u> get in trouble. With this new protocol, you are supposed to leave the building quickly if that is an option at all. Your teacher may in fact tell you to evacuate.
- No. Your class or schools may talk about ideas for places to run to, but the most important thing is to go quickly and get as far away from the building as possible. There will be plenty of first responders out in the neighborhood in a matter of minutes to help you. Find a safe adult once you can no longer see the building.
- How will my parents find me? The District will get information to your parents on where they can come pick you up. It will not be at our school or where you might evacuate to...it will be at another location, like a Walmart or the fire station where you will be transported to be reunited with your family.
