





Elective classes~

After required coursework (5.5 credits), 6th graders have room for 1.5 elective credits for a total of 7.0 credits.

- Quarter electives (0.25)
- Semester electives (0.5)
- Year electives (1.0)

We start with any Semester/Yearlong Electives:

- Band 6 (1.0= all year)
- Choir 6 (1.0= all year or 0.5= one semester is also an option in 6th grade)
- Orchestra 6 (1.0= all year)

By recommendation only~

- Resource (1.0= all year as per IEP)
- Quest (0.5 or 1.0= all year is suggested, but at least a semester)*
- Guided Study (0.25= one quarter, 0.5= one semester or 1.0= all year)

Option 1:

Full year class (Choir) = 1.0 credit 2 quarter classes = 0.5 credit

Option 3:

Semester class (Choir) = 0.5 credit 4 quarter classes = 1.0 credit

Option 4:

6 quarter classes = 1.5 credits
