Main Application Pathways

College Specific Platform

For students interested in applying to one college

The Common App

For all students who interested in applying to multiple schools

The Coalition App

For underrepresented students with significant financial need applying to multiple schools

QuestBridge

For high-achieving low income students aiming to attend the nation's top colleges on a full-ride

Who QuestBridge is looking for

General

- US citizens or permanent residents

OR

- Students attending high school in the US, regardless of citizenship status

Academic Achievement

- Earn primarily A's in the most challenging courses offered
- Rank within the top 5-10% of the their class
- The 25%-75% range of submitted scores are 1280-1470 for SAT or 27-33 for ACT
- Strong writing skills
- Intellectual curiosity

Financial Qualifications

- Typically from households earning less than \$65,000 annually for a household of four
- Minimal assets
- May have extenuating circumstances impacting household finances

Personal Circumstances

- Demonstrate strength in character and resilience
- Involved in or hold leadership roles in extracurricular activities
- Often first-generation college students

Frequently asked question

Can I apply if my household income is more than \$65,000?

Most Finalists are from households earning less than \$65,000 per year for a household of four with minimal assets. However, there are no absolute cut-offs.

If you feel you have faced economic hardship, and that you fit the criteria of being a high-achieving student from a low-income background, QuestBridge encourages you to apply. There is room on the application to explain your household's financial situation.

Note that if you email QuestBridge with specific questions pertaining to income eligibility, they will not be able to give specific responses as they must see a full application to determine financial eligibility.

Special awards and resources to prepare high school juniors to apply to the nation's best colleges.




National College Match

What makes QuestBridge unique?



National College Match Timeline



Late Summer

Rank up to 15 college partners


November

Mid-December

Submit the QuestBridge Regular Decision Form to be considered for admission and generous financial aid to additional college partners



Ranking and matching

Students must rank colleges to participate in the Match.



Students create a list in which they **rank up to 15 college partners** to be considered for early admission with the Match Scholarship.



College partners review applications and select who **they are able to admit with the Match Scholarship**. They do not know where students ranked them.

Finalists who are matched:

- Are matched to their highest ranked school that is also able to match with them
- Are matched to one school
- Have committed to attend the school they are matched to as it is a binding admissions process



