You should bring the following items to the exam:

- **PICTURE ID: school ID OR driver's license**
- If you are taking a digital or hybrid exam, your CHARGED laptop and power cord. Bluebook must be installed and the computer must be restarted the morning of the exam to ensure all updates are pushed out.
- You must know your College Board account sign in credentials.
- Several sharpened No. 2 pencils (with erasers) for all multiple-choice answer sheets.
- Pens with black or dark blue ink for completing areas on the exam booklet covers and for free-response questions in most exams.
- A calculator with the necessary capabilities if you're taking an Environmental Science, Calculus, Biology, Chemistry, Physics, or Statistics Exam. Visit <https://tinyurl.com/ypv37nda>

- A ruler or straightedge if you're taking an AP Physics Exam.

You should not bring the following into the exam room:

- **Electronic equipment** including phones, smartwatches, fitness trackers, wearable technology, cameras, recording or listening devices, or any other type of electronic, Bluetooth or communication device. Clocks will be large and visible from all areas of the testing rooms. **Leave these items at home or locked in your vehicle.**
- Books, compasses, colored pencils, correction fluid, dictionaries, highlighters, stylus pens or notes
- Rulers and straightedges (except as noted above)
- Ear plugs/buds
- Scratch paper (will be provided)
- Portable listening or recording devices (even with headphones) or photographic equipment
- Food or drink-you may leave this outside the room
- Clothing with subject-related information
- Head coverings are not permitted unless worn for medical or religious reasons. During testing they cannot obstruct the test taker's eyes and ears. Other head coverings (hats, brimmed caps, etc.) are not permitted while testing. Hooded sweatshirts hoods must remain down.

You are required to arrive at the testing site no later than 15 minutes prior to your exam for a paper/pencil in person exam: 7:45 a.m. for the morning administration; 11:45 a.m. for the afternoon administration. Students **may not** be dismissed until an exam has officially ended. Do not ask to leave early if you finish before the end of the test as your request will be denied. If you play a sport or have a job, it will be your responsibility to inform your coach or employer of your AP obligation and arrangements should be made accordingly. Please clear all AP absences with your coach, employer or sponsor. The AP exams are approximately **4 hours** in length. For example, if an exam starts at noon, it is not scheduled to be done until 4 PM.

Students WILL NOT be permitted to start a test late and no testing refunds will be given to a student who is late.

Students are responsible for arranging their own transportation to the testing sites. There is parking close to all sites. If you are testing at the IRC or Tech Center, parking is **extremely limited**, please carpool!!!! Parents may pick up their students after an exam but may not wait in the exam area for their student.

Students who miss classes for an AP exam are expected to make up all work missed in a timely manner. It is suggested that you contact your teacher soon to arrange for work **prior** to exam day.

Get a good night's rest before your test and eat a nutritious breakfast. You are allowed to bring a snack and beverage for your 10-minute break. However, eating and drinking is prohibited while you are taking an exam. **It is advisable to bring a sweater or light jacket in case the room temperature is below your comfort level. If you choose to wear a hoodie sweatshirt, the hood will need to remain down.**

You are required to abide by the policies of both the College Board and Olathe East High School during the exam period. Any misconduct will be reported and could jeopardize your AP Exam grade.
