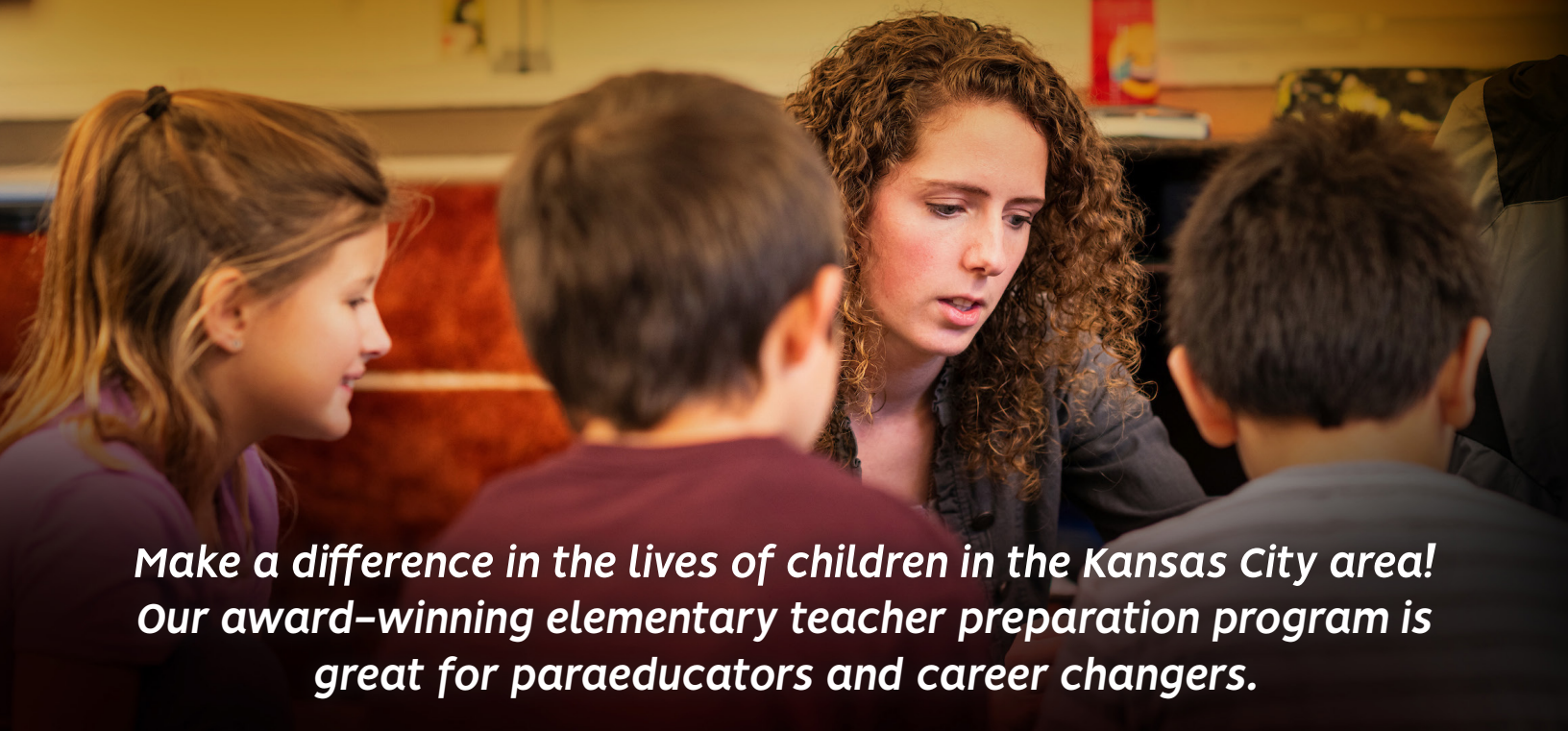


PARAEDUCATORS!

Our Program

STEP ONE:

Work with an elementary education advisor to create a personalized degree plan. If you have previously taken college courses, your advisor will determine which can be applied to a Bachelor of Science degree in Elementary Education (BSE).

STEP TWO:

Complete any needed general education courses at Johnson County Community College.

STEP THREE:

Transfer to Emporia State University's two-year elementary education program, offered entirely in Johnson County.

- During your first year of study, courses are offered in the late afternoon and evening in Overland Park, Kansas as well as online—ideal for individuals who are balancing school, life, and work.
- During the second year of study, you will complete a year-long student teaching internship in Olathe Public Schools.

STEP FOUR:

Upon successful completion of all BSE requirements, use your Kansas Teacher Certification to teach grades kindergarten through six in the state of Kansas.
