Science State	The Kansas State Assessments fall under the
Assessment	umbrella of the Kansas Assessment Program or
	KAP. Students in grade 5 participate in the science
	state assessment which measures a student's
	mastery of state science standards.
Social Studies State	The Social Studies State Assessment falls under the
Assessment	umbrella of the Kansas Assessment Program or
	KAP. All 4 th graders participate in this assessment;
	however, it is not a traditional state assessment, as
	it may look/feel more like a project or writing
	assignment and is embedded into the 4 th grade
	Social Studies curriculum.
FastBridge Math Suite	Students in grades preK-5 participate in the
(includes earlyMath)	FastBridge Math assessments three times per year.
	These are broad screening measures of math
