

## COMMUNITY GUIDELINES FOR CBAC/ODAC FACILITY AND FIELD USE

Olathe Public Schools is pleased to offer community use of district turf fields within the following guidelines:

- NO METAL CLEATS ALLOWED.
- Permit holder must have rental confirmation in their possession when using the field as proof of scheduled use of the facility.
- Any changes in requested field time must be made prior to 48 hours before scheduled use.
- Permit holder agrees to enforce the District's policy with regard to the prohibited use of tobacco, alcohol or other drugs in the stadium and/or adjoining parking lots.
- Sportsmanlike conduct is expected at all times on Olathe Public Schools' fields.
- Permit holder agrees to confine all spectators to the grandstand area. Only participants are to be on the playing fields or surrounding track if applicable.
- Groups/Responsible Parties renting the facility are responsible for supervising young children.
- Permit holder agrees to respect and adhere to requests made by on-site USD 233 personnel. Ongoing non-compliance may result in additional fees and/or loss of future rental access.
- Arrival time is no more than 30 minutes before event. Field access will not be granted until scheduled time.
- The District is not responsible for the personal property of the permit holder or individuals attending events scheduled by the permit holder.
- Team banners will be allowed with the following stipulations:
  - No permanent banners are allowed.
  - Banners must be approved in advance by district personnel.
  - No construction will be permitted for banners and the organization renting the facility assumes responsibility for any damage that may be caused by hanging a banner.
  - Banners are immediately removed following the event.
  - Banners will not cover or hide any existing signs, banners or advertising already in place by USD 233.
- In the event of lightning or extreme heat, supervisory personnel have the authority to cancel the event.
- The District reserves the right to cancel previously scheduled events if deemed necessary due to field conditions.
- Trash receptacles are provided and emptied on a regular basis. Please pick up trash at the end of each field use to ensure additional fees are not assessed. This includes dugouts and bull pens.
- No open flames allowed in the stadium or in the parking lot.
- No animals allowed on the premises with the exception of service dogs.
- No sharp objects, including tent stakes, corner flags or other objects that can penetrate the surface of the field.
- Firearms are not permitted at ODAC or CBAC.
- No drinks other than water allowed on the field.
- Absolutely **no gum or shelled seeds** (sunflower, peanuts, etc.) are allowed inside the fence line surrounding the playing fields and track or in the dugouts.
- Report any damages, vandalism, or unusual circumstances before, during or after the event to USD 233 Facility Usage Department.

*Supervisory personnel needs for each individual use will be determined and assigned by the Facility Usage Office.*
